You are invited to take advantage of the MOBILE ECO CENTER Saturday May 1st, from 9 to 12. At the Municipalite of Newport, 1452 route 212.

This service is offered free of charge.

Your municipalities get \$'s back when hosting a Mobile Echo Center. Big garbage goes to land fill that is very costly.

We will respect the sanitary measures put in place by the Public Health department. A team will be on site in order to answer your questions as well as guide you to the containers reserved for specific items. Please note that due to social distancing participants will be responsible for handling his or her own items.

Accepted materials :

- Electronics (computers, televisions, keyboards, cellphones, printers, ink cartridges...); <https://www.recyclemyelectronics.ca/qc/what-can-i-recycle/>
- Wood (natural, treated or painted);
- Electrical appliances (fridges, stoves...);
- All metals;
- Garden waste (pruning and gardening clippings, leaves and branches less than 5 feet in length);
- Polystyrene foam (food containers) rinsed and cleaned. e.g. meat and vegetable packing from stores;
- Textiles (clothing, curtains...);
- Oil;
- Paint (residential);
- Porcelaine (sinks, toilets);
- Concrete blocks, bricks;
- Tires (car and pick-up tires without rim).

Materials refused :

- Asphalt shingles;
- All vinyls and styrofoam;
- PCBs and cyanides;
- Tires on rims;
- Stumps and contaminated soil;
- Animal carcasses;
- All kitchen waste;
- Ammunition and explosives;
- Biomedical waste (seringes, needles, tubing and expired medication...);
- Boxes of mixed materials;
- Overly large loads could be refused by team on site.
